The TN Reading Research Center is hiring hourly student workers to support an IES-funded meta-analysis of published research findings. Students will review and code research articles to determine if they meet inclusion criteria for the meta-analysis. Students also may extract specific information from the articles according to a protocol.

Pay is \$12 per hour for undergraduates or \$15 per hour for graduate students. The expected time commitment is 10-12 hours of work per week.

While working on this job, students will:

- Gain experience working in a professional environment.
- Learn skills for conducting meta-analyses such as reviewing and coding research articles using a defined protocol.
- Use software for conducting systematic reviews and meta-analyses, such as Covidence and MetaReviewer.
- Receive feedback on their performance.

Responsibilities:

- Review and code research articles using specified criteria and other protocols.
- Maintain reliability with team members working on the project.
- Meet daily and weekly goals for completing articles.
- Arrive to work on time, ready to work, and dressed appropriately (business casual).
- Exhibit professional conduct within the work environment.

Required Qualifications:

- Attention to detail.
- Experience reading published research articles.
- Ability to accept feedback and adapt accordingly.
- A strong work ethic.
- Ability to work independently or as part of a team.
- Must be currently enrolled as a student at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience conducting systematic reviews or meta-analyses.
